The late Councillor John McMahon, of Fitzroy, Melbourne, was an assiduous collector for many years of books on Australia, particularly on the early days, about which he frequently wrote interesting articles in the newspapers. This fine collection has been presented to the Newman College, at the University. It contains many rare items, which in this way will be preserved for future students of Australian history.

Death of Mr John M'Mahon

Mr John M'Mahon, J.P., formerly Mayor of Fitzroy, died at a late hour last night at Uxbridge House, private hospital, Nicholson street, Fitzroy, after a long illness. He was in his seventy-third year. Mr M'Mahon was for many years a member of the Fitzroy Council, and until his death failed, sat regularly on the Fitzroy Bench. He also carried on business as a tailor in Brunswick street for many years, but retired from active commercial life some time ago. In the land boom time Mr M'Mahon, in conjunction with the late Mr Samuel Lyons (Lyons and Turner, solicitors), placed a number of properties, which they had acquired, on the market. These properties were mostly about Fairfield, Northcote, and adjoining districts, and when they were sub-divided and offered for sale, attracted considerable attention. Mr M'Mahon stood several times for the State Parliament, but was never successful. He was one of the founders of the Fitzroy Football Club, and though of recent years he had frequently lived out of the district, he always took a prominent part in efforts associated with the welfare of Fitzroy. Three of Mr M'Mahon's sons, all doctors, are now at the war. The funeral, a private one, took place this afternoon.
